## SCHOLARSHIP/DISTRICT COMPETITION RULES

- 1. Entrants and their teachers must follow all National rules, as outlined in the NFMC Bulletin.
- 2. Teachers who wish to enter students in the Scholarship or District competition must be a Federated member of Virtuoso Club, in good standing, for a minimum of 2 years.
- 3. Students who wish to enter the District Competition:
  - Must be entered by a teacher who has been a member of Virtuoso Club for a minimum of 2 years.
  - Must be in 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
  - May not have won the district competition in the year prior.
  - Additionally, **PIANO** students must be playing at the Difficult 1 level, or higher.
- 4. Students who wish to enter the Camp Scholarship Competition:
  - Must be entered by a teacher who has been a member of Virtuoso Club for a minimum of 2 years.
  - Must have participated in at least 1 previous Federation Festival.
  - Must indicate on the entry form what camp they plan to attend.
  - If awarded funds, must inform the Gold Cup chairperson if either they plan to attend a different camp than originally listed or they cannot attend any summer camp due to extenuating circumstances.
  - May not have been awarded a summer camp scholarship by Virtuoso Club in the year prior.
- 5. Students who wish to enter the College Scholarship Competition:
  - Must be entered by a teacher who has been a member of Virtuoso Club for a minimum of 2 years.
  - Must be in 12<sup>th</sup> grade, graduating in the year competing.
  - Must provide references who can verify that they have participated in a music community for a minimum of 3 years (i.e. Federation Festivals, school or extracurricular music ensembles, church music ministry, private lessons, etc.)
  - Must provide documentation of acceptance to a music school as a music MAJOR to receive funds. Music minors will not be awarded funds.
  - If awarded funds, must inform the Gold Cup chairperson if they change their major prior to the beginning of the school year for which the funds were awarded.
